## **Distinguished Patrons of the Year**

This year's "Distinguished Patrons of the Year" have been selected and you are personally invited to St. Mary Spring Scholarship Gala Saturday, May 15, 6:00 p.m at The Hasbrouck Heights Hilton to honor their loyal dedication to St. Mary High School.

### **Robert E. Campbell '51**

A 1951 graduate of St. Mary High School, Robert E. Campbell, is a retired Vice Chairman of The Board of Directors of Johnson & Johnson (J&J) and was also Chairman of the Professional Sector Worldwide. He joined J&J in 1955 – and his lifelong career in financial and general management helped J&J diversify its offerings to become an international leader in consumer health, medical devices and surgical instruments. Mr. Campbell is an Air Force veteran. He holds an MBA from Rutgers University, and honorary degrees from Fordham University and the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey. He contributes his healthcare industry expertise and business acumen to guide organizations in policy, medical research and education. He is a past Trustee and Chairman of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and now serves as an advisor to The Cancer Institute of New Jersey, the College of Science of the University of Notre Dame and an Overseer of The Robert Wood Johnson Medical School. Mr. Campbell brings his community-minded spirit to the boards of local healthcare providers, the arts and patient organizations. Cited for his personal philanthropy, Mr. Campbell is a past recipient of the Diocese of Metuchen's Humanitarian of the Year Award. Mr. Campbell and his wife, Joan, are the parents of four children and have nine grandchildren.

### **Reverend Gloria Cephas Killings**

Honored as a distinguished educator and coach and for service to her community, Reverend Gloria Cephas Killings has taught at St. Mary High School longer than anyone – 45 years. Reverend Killings has taught physical education, religion, health and driver's education. She coached the girls' basketball team for nine years and brought them to the State Championships in 1971, where they finished second. She is proud of developing the school tradition "Freshmen Night of Togetherness." The Archdiocese of Newark has recognized Reverend Killings as a "Teacher of the Year." She is also an Associate of the Dominican Sisters of Caldwell, NJ, Reverend Killings resides in Passaic and is Associate Minister of Union Baptist Church there. She is active in the faith formation and leadership of the Northern New Jersey Baptist Convention.

### **Jack Jones '56**

Jack began and finished his illustrious teaching and coaching career at his alma mater St. Mary High School. In between Jack had notable success winning numerous conference and 3 state championships at Immaculate Conception H.S ( Montclair), Depaul H.S Wayne) and Clifton H.S. Coach Jones has been inducted to each school Hall of Fame as well as the state of New Jersey's Coaches Hall of Fame. However many alumni fondly remember Mr. Jones for his exceptional abilities as a Math teacher. Mr. Jones was chairperson of the Math Department and wrote the

curriculum for the subject in 2006.

### **Vincent & Judith Calviello**

Both Vincent & Judith have served the parish and schools of St. Mary for over thirty five years. Vincent was a member of the parish council, a Religious Education teacher, and a trustee of our parish. Vincent was a PTA president, a member of the Finance Committee, and helped organize a Committee to plan the future of St. Mary High School in 1985 when our school was in danger of closing. Judith served our parish as Religious Education Principal, Eucharistic Minister, First Communion and Penance Coordinator, as well as a member of the Parish Council and Education Committee. Judith became involved in the high school as a Librarian before becoming Administrative Assistant to Principal Mary Lanni. Judith's tenure as the schools Mock Trail Coach is still remembered today for competing in the national finals. Mrs. Calviello has been honored by the Archdiocese of Newark for her contributions to catholic education and by the Borough of Rutherford, and the United States Congress for her work in Civil Rights.
