The *GAEL FOR A DAY* program at St. Mary High School is a great way for prospective students to experience our school. The program is open to 8th grade students from October 1st until May 30th. Starting in March, we welcome 7th grade students to join us as well.

Your son or daughter may request a freshman student to shadow if one is known, otherwise a student will be assigned to host your son or daughter. Selections are based on similar interests in academics, clubs, sports, elementary school, and hometown.

The *GAEL FOR A DAY* should arrive with a parent between 7:30 am and 7:45 am to meet with our Principal Mr. Roy Corso, Mr. Sweet, and the student's host for the day. Parents are welcome and encouraged to join us for a brief introduction and will be given the opportunity to ask questions. Our school day ends at 2:36 pm, at which time the student may be picked up in the front lobby. Parents and visiting *GAELS* are also welcome to meet with Mr. Corso at the end of the day to provide feedback on their experience.

All students will be provided with a free Lunch Voucher and a letter to excuse their absence from school while they participate in our program. Students are asked to dress appropriately. We do not require uniforms be worn on that day.
